What is a PPG?

A patient participation group is a group of patients, registered at a particular practice, who work together to share ideas and take a more active interest in developing their practice and influencing local healthcare services.

Previous PPG Projects

- Organised Thai Chi sessions for patients at BHC.
- Suggested improvements to seating area layout.
- Support national campaigns such as Carers Week UK.
- Developing information leaflets for physical and social activities available in Bicester.
- Volunteering during Seasonal Vaccination Sessions.

What would be required of me if I join the PPG?

There are two type of PPG members– Virtual Members, or Face to Face Members.

Virtual Members are sent via email agendas and minutes from the Face to Face Meetings. There is no requirement to attend any meetings.

Face to Face Members are a subset of the Virtual Members, made up of around a dozen people who want to attend meetings about issues affecting the practice, and to undertake projects to help out. The group meet every couple of months.

The virtual group can contact the Face to Face group with any feedback they may wish to be raised at the meetings.
